What to Bring?

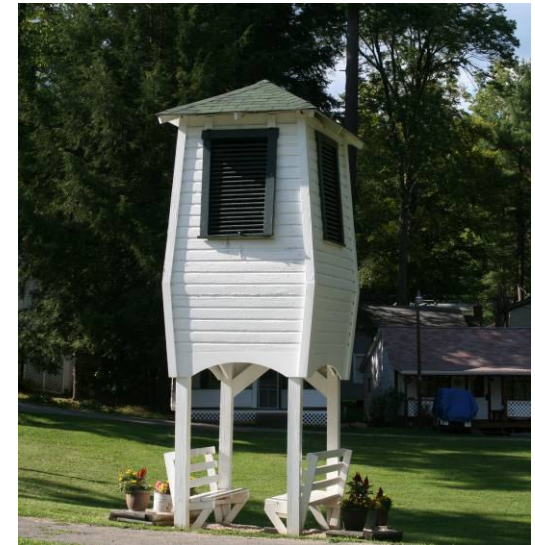
