

Mahaffey Youth Camps are a ministry of Mahaffey Camp & Conference Center. The Youth Camps are designed for children and youth of specific ages to get together, have fun, meet new friends and learn more about God, His love and plans for them as an individual. Each day is full of planned hands-on activities including Bible lessons, crafts, recreation and missions. Located on Rt. 219 and situated on 45 acres, Mahaffey Camp offers a unique camping experience. The campers will stay in newly remodeled dorms with assigned adult supervision. Large recreational areas provide fun and adventure including soccer, mini-golf, basketball and softball.

Kids' Camp June 21—26 offers learning experiences geared to challenge campers spiritually. Daily Bible lessons, memorization and missions emphasis highlight the program. Campers enjoy crafts, recreation, river adventures and nature hikes as they explore God's great outdoors. There will be new friends to meet, great counselors and loads of fun at recreation and crafts. Kids' Camp includes an off-site excursion to Lakemont Park.

Teen Camp June 7—12 is filled with a variety of spectacular opportunities including Bible study, worship, river rafting, along with concerts and thrilling evening events. New this year will be an extreme adventure day filled with challenges for all!

Horse Camp August 2—7 will be a week that will be filled with fun and adventure! No equine experience is needed to attend, with campers being grouped on level of experience. Campers will have availability to apply the skills they have learned. On site instruction will include practical horsemanship skills including basic riding, how to take care of a horse, cleaning stalls, and safety lessons. New for 2009: Intermediate level instruction will be offered to qualifying alumni campers. Early registration is suggested due to a limited amount of campers accepted.

Junior Camp June 14—19

Daily small group Bible studies, dynamic speakers and worship, including compelling team challenges are the focus during Jr. Camp week. Lakemont Park excursion, team building events and late night adventures will provide out of the ordinary awesome experiences.

Soccer Sports Camp June 28—July 2 will incorporate skill building, individual technique and team attitudes. Each camper will receive a regulation ball upon sign in at camp. Indoor and outdoor facilities will complement this camp as the camper excels athletically in a great spiritual environment. Chapel will be held daily.

Young Explorer's Camp June 28—30
follows a modified schedule of Kids' Camp offering a two day independent experience with action packed activities including Bible time, recreation & craft time. Campers, be prepared to meet real-life young explorers Christopher Columbus and Dr. David Livingstone, missionary to Africa, and learn how God led their exciting explorations to new lands!
