

Camp Regulations

PURPOSE:

Mahaffey Camp exists for the express purpose of spiritual ministry to all age groups. It is very important that this emphasis be maintained. For this reason certain regulations apply on the grounds at all times, for all cottage, dormitory, tent and trailer occupants, as well as all other guests.

DRESS:

This is a church camp therefore modesty in dress is expected. Modesty is propriety (or the state of being proper) in speech, dress, and conduct. Attire is different for different places and situations. Language and conduct unbecoming to Christ is not acceptable on the campground.

TOBACCO:

Smoking and the use of tobacco in any form anywhere on the campground is positively forbidden at all times.

DRUGS and ALCOHOL:

Having in possession, using, or offering to others the use of any alcoholic beverages drugs of any kind (unless prescribed by a physician) is strictly forbidden at all times on the campground.

PETS:

Dogs and cats are not permitted on the grounds during the Camp Meeting period. At all other times, pets must be under the control of their owners.

BICYCLES:

Bicycles are not permitted on the sidewalks and may not be used during Family Camp.

MOTOBIKES:

Motor bikes, motorcycles, and all-terrain vehicles are not permitted, except to come and go from the camp. These must observe the speed limits and are not permitted on the sidewalks.

GOLF CARTS:

Golf carts must observe the speed limit and stay off the sidewalks.

SPEED LIMIT:

The speed limit is 10 MPH.

HUNTING AND FIREARMS:

No hunting shall be permitted on the grounds at anytime, and no firearms or air rifles are permitted on the grounds between may 1 and September 30.

SUNDAY OBSERVANCE :

Regulations regarding the Lord's Day apply during the entire year. No carpentry or other types of work on buildings is permitted on Sunday.

RADIOS, TAPEPLAYERS, CDS, ETC :

These are only permitted to be used in cottages, dorms, tents, or trailers and must be at a level that will not disturb others. Earphones are recommended.

OFF LIMITS :

The areas of the woods beyond the Camp perimeter and the area along the river bank are off limits from the beginning of the evening service (6:45 p.m.) until the rising bell in the morning (6:30 a.m.)

YOUTH UNDER 18 :

All youth 18 and under whose parents or legal guardians are not staying with them at same site, dorm room, or cottage must have an adult (25 years or older) who will sign a Youth Sponsor form.

ATTENTION PARENTS AND GUARDIANS :

(1) The District or Camp cannot be responsible for unchaperoned young people. (2) On the last Sunday night of Camp, parents returning home before the Sunday Evening Service are expected to take their young people with them and not leave them on the grounds unchaperoned. No young people are allowed to stay in the dorms without their parent staying with them.

GARBAGE DISPOSAL :

No garbage or the disposal of any plastic containers, bags or disposable diapers should be placed in the public toilets or gray water holding pits.

ALL GARBAGE OF THE AFORE MENTIONED SHOULD BE PLACED IN THE DUMPSTERS DURING FAMILY CAMP, OR IN CANS PROVIDED IN VARIOUS AREAS OF THE CAMPGROUND.

Only garbage should be placed in the dumpster.

Leaves should be bagged and placed along the side of the street. NO furniture is to be put in the dumpster.

Furniture and appliances are to be hauled away from the camp by the owner.

FIREWORKS :

Fireworks of any kind are not permitted on the grounds at anytime. Violators will be dismissed from the campgrounds.

RENTAL OF ALL CAMP FACILITIES :

(1) No one may renew a reservation for a Camp facility if they have failed to personally occupy the same for two consecutive years.

(2) All rental facilities must be registered by those who will occupy the same during the Camp period.

(3) Those who are in charge of the various rental facilities shall have a list of ALL occupants residing in the rental facility. This list will be kept at the Assignment Office.

SINGLE GUYS AND GIRLS :

No single girls or fellows (except family members) shall be allowed in Camp rented facilities occupied by single people of the opposite sex. Single persons under 21 years of age are not permitted to stay overnight in any cottage, mobile home, or recreational vehicle without an adult in the same residence.

SUBLETTING OF RENTAL FACILITIES :

There will be no personal subletting for Camp rented facilities. Only those registered for the particular facility will be allowed to use the same. The person who is registered for the particular facility will be responsible for the same.
